#### All Clear Zone

# CONTINUE ACTIVITIES AS USUAL

- No fever
- No increase in shortness of breath
- No increase in the amount, thickness or color of mucous (phlegm or sputum)



### Warning Zone

#### **CALL YOUR DOCTOR IF YOU HAVE:**

- More trouble breathing than usual
- New cough, or a cough that is worse than usual
- A change in color, amount, or thickness from normal mucous (phlegm or sputum)
- Fever above 100.4° Fahrenheit



### **Medical Alert Zone**

# GO TO THE EMERGENCY ROOM OR CALL 911 IF YOU HAVE:

- Struggling to breathe or can't catch your breath
- Heart is "racing"
- Can't think clearly or feeling confused
- Feeling dizzy or lightheaded
- Have sudden chest pain that does not go away

### Use These Questions to Determine Your Zone

- ? Have you used your **rescue inhalers** or oxygen more often?
- ? Is there any change in your **breathing**?
- ? Are you able to participate in usual daily activities?
- ? Do you have **chest pain**? Is this new or more frequent?
- ? Any changes in color, amount, or thickness from your mucous?
- ? Any changes in your appetite?
